# **Urgent Priority Actions**

(Updated November 10, 2015)

### **Purpose**

Provide a list of Urgent Priority Actions which should be implemented as rapidly as possible

#### **Objective**

- To help coordinate, prioritize, "sequence" and implement priority **Actions** while the project management system is being developed and implemented.
- As standard platform issues for candidates for office.
- As issues for candidate debates

#### Actions

Public Servants working with the people refine and implement the below **Urgent Priority Actions** as rapidly as possible. Additional Priority Actions will be added to the Agenda as we go along and the entire **Common Agenda** should be completed before the end of the 114<sup>th</sup> Congress. The numbered items are the Action Plans that group related Actions. This list is tentative because we want anyone who likes to add proposed Actions.

- #18. Take all Nuclear Weapons off Alert. End All U.S. Wars, Occupations, Use of Force, Sanctions, Military Alliances and Empire Building. Apologize and Pay Reparations to Countries Harmed by the U.S. .Close Overseas Bases and Bring all Troops and Contractors Home (The Kellogg-Briand Pact of 1928 outlawed all wars and requires that the settlement or solution of all disputes or conflicts of whatever nature or of whatever origin they may be, which may arise among them, shall never be sought except by pacific means. Legislators cannot legally authorize presidents to use force. See Proof of the Unconstitutionality and Illegality of the U.S. Wars/Occupations and Use of Force);
- #2. Ensure Everyone in the World has at Least the Basic Necessities of Life as Rapidly as Possible—no Later Than December 20, 2015 for the U.S.—by Accelerating the UN Millennium and Sustainability Development Goals. See Action Plans #2 and #20;
- #1. Ensure Jobs at Meaningful Work and Living Wages Are Available for All primarily to provide affordable Needs and Necessities for a Decent Life for All Humankind Now and in the Future;
- #22. <u>Prevent an Economic Crisis or Depression, End the Recession, Nationalize</u> the Federal Reserve, End Foreclosures and Provide Community Banking;
- #25. <u>Decrease the Rate and Degree of Global Warming and Mitigate its Adverse</u>
  <u>Effects</u>, including in particular:
  - #7. <u>Build, Maintain and Operate a Comprehensive, Nationwide, Rail-Maglev Based, Transportation System Integrated with Local and International Systems Will Significantly Reduce Automobile and Air Travel;</u>
    - #19. Permanently Disarm, Demilitarize, Phase Out and Outlaw All Offensive Weapons and Standing Armed Forces. Convert 90% of all DOD-MIC

## <u>Personnel, Resources, Spending and Contracts for Use for Peaceful</u> <u>Purposes with Transfers But No Involuntary Layoffs;</u>

- #32. At All Levels of All Governments Eliminate Income, Sales, Estate, Corporate and All Other Taxes With One Exception -- a Progressive Property Tax on the Net Assets of All Individuals, Corporations, Businesses and Other Entities with More than \$1 Million in Net Assets. Provide Generous Tax Deductions Based on Worthiness of Charitable Causes Being Supported. Everyone, in particular the 1%, should be educated as to the value of such a tax as it is implemented:
- #28. Support and Enforce the Rule of Law in Particular the Universal Declaration of Human Right and the Kellogg-Briand Pact;
- #20. Fully fund, reform and strengthen the United Nations, its Peacekeepers and Agencies, World Court, International Criminal Court (ICC) and INTERPOL and provide these organizations the authority to enforce international laws and rapidly help settle conflicts and disputes by peaceful, legal means. In particular:
  - The United States ratify the UN's "Rome Statute" and participate fully in the International Criminal Court (ICC) and encourage all other countries to do likewise
- 1. Provide funds from the <u>Summary of Funding Sources</u> to accomplish the work in the strategic plan, eliminate deficit spending, pay down the national debt and end sequestration and austerity programs. In particular:
  - #15. Provide Humane, Constitutional Immigration Laws and Practices Considering that the U. S. Purchased 2/3rds of Mexico for \$20 million in 1848 at Gun Point.
  - #16. <u>Make elections about candidates' character and positions on Issues/actions;</u> <u>strictly limit campaign contributions, get all corporate money out of elections and</u> reform elections
  - #14. <u>Vacate as null and Void Citizens United and Scores of Other Unconstitutional</u>
     <u>Court Rulings without Amending the Constitution and Repair the Damages</u>
